We are looking for projects that meet ALL of the following criteria:

- 1. The primary purpose of the project is to **improve mental health and wellbeing outcomes** of a community.
- 2. The project will **help people meaningfully connect** in their local community.
- 3. The project is a **locally-led and locally-delivered** project that benefits a community.

Incorporated not-for-profit Australian organisations that provide community benefit are encouraged to apply. See the **2021 Australia Post Community Grants Guidelines** for full eligibility.
